SECTION 1. PURPOSE. The Town of Guilford finds that the Wahlberg Road in the Town of Guilford which is a Town Road has been and is being severely damaged by the use of overweight vehicles. The purpose of this law is to protect and preserve said road by imposing restrictions on those vehicles driving over said road.

SECTION 2. SHORT TITLE. The title of this local law shall be "Posting of Wahlberg Road."

SECTION 3. RESTRICTIONS. It shall be unlawful for any motor vehicle to be driven upon the Wahlberg Road in the Town of Guilford, Chenango County, New York, that has a weight in excess of five (5) tons per axle. This restriction shall be a year-round restriction on said Wahlberg Road.

SECTION 4. PENALTIES. Upon conviction, a violation of this local law shall be deemed an offense and punishable by a fine not exceeding One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) for the first offense and Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for each offense thereafter.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This local law shall take effect immediately upon its filing in the Office of the Secretary of State in accordance with the provisions of Section 27 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.




